Wherever I am, my heart is always with you appa to share all your sorrows and discomforts.

There were three letters one to Darjeeling, one to George & one to Anna. George's was in every line a reply to his letter though written several days previously, almost anticipating his very thoughts.

No doubt the blow was severe. But thank God I am well sustained. I believe that I did not betray myself when I appeared in Court soon after the terrible event. Ammachi is always in my mind as an inspiration. Not that I am in deep mourning. I am not weeping & lose her so much for that.
